
John Day Regional Map: Camping & Services

The services shown on the map are open during the summer season, but some may be closed 1-2 days per week. Some services are not available during the winter.

Although it is legal to pump your own fuel in much of Eastern Oregon, many local stations do not have self-pay pumps. Gas stations close between 5pm and 8pm, and often earlier on Sundays. Towns labeled with the gas station icon should have fuel available seven days per week in the summer.
