Mount Rainier Citizen Ranger Quest Program Match the Tracks Challenge! Longmire Area Citizen Ranger Quest #5

Introduction: This “Match the Tracks Challenge” Quest will help you to have fun while you learn about your national park. Get to know some of the mammals that inhabit the park by matching their track with their picture.

Materials Needed: Your questing skills (love of adventure, wonder, curiosity, creativity); the flip-top tracks and mammals exhibit at the Longmire Information Center; a Ranger to time you.

Other: This activity counts as one Quest towards the four needed to become a Mount Rainier National Park Citizen Ranger. Get your certificate and first stamp after completing one Quest. Complete four Quests to earn the unique Citizen Ranger patch.

Directions: Get to know the tracks of some of the Mammals in the park using the flip-top exhibit in the Longmire Information Center. When you think you can successfully match the picture of the mammals with their track drawing, tell the Ranger at the desk you are ready for the challenge! The ranger at the desk will mix up the pictures and tracks and then let you try to correctly match them. Once you successfully match all of the tracks you have completed the “Match the Tracks Challenge Quest.” If you get any matches wrong though... you must start over! If you wish, the ranger can time you as you try to break the record time!
