## Determination of Temporary Closure

### 36 CFR 1.5 Closures and Public Use Limits

(a) Consistent with applicable legislation and federal administrative policies, and based upon a determination that such action is necessary for the maintenance of public health and safety, protection of environmental or scenic values, protection of natural or cultural resources, aid to scientific research, implementation of management responsibilities, equitable allocation and use of facilities, or the avoidance of conflict among visitor use activities, the Superintendent may:

- (1). Establish, for all or a portion of a park area, a reasonable schedule of visiting hours, impose public use limits, or close all or a portion of a park area to all public use or to a specific use activity.

<b>1. Temporary Closure Location:</b> Kehoe Beach and access trail	
<b>2. Duration of Temporary Closure:</b> February 26, 2022 until further notice	
<b>3. Who is affected by the Temporary Closure:</b> This area is closed to all visitors, contractors and employees not associated with the salvage removal of fishing vessel that is aground on Kehoe Beach.	
<b>4. Justification for Temporary Closure:</b> This closure is due to a fishing vessel that has come aground on Kehoe Beach. The vessel is not stabilized and presents a risk to beachgoers. A salvage operation is underway that may utilize motorized vehicles and will involve numerous personnel to remove fuel and other hazardous pollutants on board. The area will be congested with people and machinery.
