

## Determination of Temporary Closure

### 36 CFR 1.5 Closures and Public Use Limits

(a) Consistent with applicable legislation and federal administrative policies, and based upon a determination that such action is necessary for the maintenance of public health and safety, protection of environmental or scenic values, protection of natural or cultural resources, aid to scientific research, implementation of management responsibilities, equitable allocation and use of facilities, or the avoidance of conflict among visitor use activities, the Superintendent may:

- (1). Establish, for all or a portion of a park area, a reasonable schedule of visiting hours, impose public use limits, or close all or a portion of a park area to all public use or to a specific use activity.

<b>1. Temporary Closure Location:</b> Schooner Bay Road	
<b>2. Duration of Temporary Closure:</b> The Schooner Bay Road will be closed from July 30 to August 2, 2018.	
<b>3. Who is affected by the Temporary Closure:</b> Except in an emergency and for the duration of the closure, vehicle use will be prohibited on the Schooner Bay Road.	
<b>4. Justification for Temporary Closure:</b> This closure is necessary to allow employees to safely perform necessary road maintenance. The road is narrow with blind corners and closing it allows the road crew to perform this work without the possibility of being hit by vehicles.	
<b>5. Additional Justification/Details for Temporary Closure</b> This closure will occur during the week, when visitor traffic is expected to be low.
