Area Protection – Sensitive Ecological Restoration Area


The southern portion of Crane Flat Meadow has been identified as a sensitive area harboring special status species. In order to protect these species, the Superintendent of Yosemite National Park is temporarily closing this area to visitor use for a duration of time in which these species are most sensitive to disturbance.


By order of the Superintendent of Yosemite National Park and under authority of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1.5(a) and Section (a)(1):

The Crane Flat Campground 300-Loop and adjacent meadow is closed annually to visitor use, beginning at the time of campground opening, and remaining in effect until July 1, or until further notice.

Notice of closure will be posted and area will be monitored to ensure compliance. Your cooperation in complying with this temporary restriction is greatly appreciated.

The designation will remain in place until rescinded.
