Interested in working for the National Park Service?

For those who have a call to public service, Assateague Island National Seashore is looking to fill Surf Lifeguard positions.

The job of the surf lifeguard is all about public safety on the ocean front. It entails preventative lifeguarding, lifesaving and search and rescue.

You will receive over 100 hours of paid training that will prepare you for this assignment. You will be trained in EMS at the Emergency Medical Responder level. You will learn how to prevent drowning, prevent injuries, provide safety education and execute effective rescues.

Our lifeguard program can set you on the right path in other career fields such

as public policy, law enforcement, exercise science, public health, business, resource management and more.

As a surf lifeguard, you will be required to complete daily in-service training that includes beach running, ocean swimming, ocean rescue drills and emergency response scenarios. Our daily in-service trainings are enjoyable and will keep you in top physical condition.

Assateague Island is a 37 mile long barrier Island along the coast of Maryland and Virginia, located approximately 130 miles east of Washington D.C. You may be assigned to either the Maryland or Virginia District locations, depending where you are most needed.

You will earn annual vacation leave and sick leave. You will be paid for federal holidays that will fall within your regularly scheduled tour of duty. Pay: \$12.19 – \$17.06 per hour

Key Requirements:

- United States citizenship required.
- Background investigation and drug test required.
- Candidate must be able to pass a swim test of 500 yards in less than 10 minutes and run 1.5 miles in 12 minutes.
