


Assateague Island National Seashore

- The north end of Assateague Island is a nursery area for nesting Piping Plovers, Least Terns, Oystercatchers, and their newly hatched chicks.
- Help us protect these important resources by observing all area closed signs.
- Please be alert – do not enter the closed area between posted signs.
- Even areas that look accessible are closed. These areas are valuable feeding grounds for chicks that are learning to forage for their own food.
- Entering a closed area is a violation of state and federal law and may result in a fine.
