Gabby Salazar is a 23 year-old photographer from Greensboro, North Carolina. When Gabby was 11 years old, her father gave her a camera and she was hooked in just a few short minutes. Since that time, Gabby has traveled throughout North America and to over fifteen countries to take photographs. In 2004 Gabby was named BBC Young Wildlife Photographer of the Year and in 2002 she won the Nature's Best Photography Youth Category.

Gabby's current project will take her to Southern Peru for 10 months on a Fulbright Grant in September of 2010. She will be working with the Amazon Conservation Association (www.amazonconservation.org) on the creation of the Los Amigos-Tambopata Conservation Corridor.
