Subject Comment to ORVAC members and ORVAC web site

Hello,

As of July 22, 2011 ORV's will be restricted to designated trails only.

As per superintendent Ramos's past comments- the door should **now** be open at long last to address some major issues that have been waiting too long already.

Those major issues that many believe should be on an upcoming agenda very soon are:

- 1 ORV Trails penetrating through the buffer zone So. of the Addition and up to the boundary So of I-75 should be installed.
- 2 Repeal of 60 day discriminatory ORV closure (16% of the year)
- 3 Repeal 10pm - 5am discriminatory ORV closure (29% of the year)

Removal of obsolete and discriminatory closures is imperative since it prohibits one particular class of American (ORV operators) from utilization and visitation to their land 45% of every year. That is unfair, oppressive, UnAmerican, inconvenient, inflexible, never necessary etc. etc.
