**** FUTURE MOON HIKE TICKETING INFORMATION**
(Can combine to both Snowshoe and Moon Hike if the environment permits.)

Dates: 21 April, 2016 (subject to change, call (435) 834 - 4747 or 4745 to verify.)

The number of visitors we can accommodate on our Full Moon Hikes is limited for safety reasons. Tickets for the Full Moon Hike will be distributed via lottery on the day of the hike. Each person in your group must be present at the lottery with the hiking shoes/boots they plan to wear. Once your footwear has passed inspection, ONE lottery ticket will be issued per group. The Ranger giving you the lottery ticket will write the number in your party (maximum of 6) on the back of your lottery ticket. If your lottery ticket is drawn, only the number of people written on the back of the winning lottery ticket will be issued hiker tickets.

Lottery Location: TBA, See Visitor Center Help Desk or call for information.

Lottery tickets issued: Beginning at 4pm MDT

Lottery begins: 4:15pm MDT sharp (No lottery tickets will be distributed once the lottery begins.)

Note: Be prepared to hike directly after the lottery for the Full Moon/Snowshoe hike.
