


# Who is Who?

4. Massachusetts Senator who presented a petition before the U. S. Senate in 1889 requesting that the government take steps to repair and protect the ruins.
6. In 1892, this US President set aside one square mile of Arizona Territory surrounding the Casa Grande Ruins as the first prehistoric and cultural reserve established in the United States.
8. Funding an expedition that visited the Casa Grande, the report on the extensive vandalism prompted this philanthropist to mount an effort to save the ruins.

## Down

1. Directed the first recorded excavations of the Casa Grande Ruins in 1887.
2. Anthropologist and historian who visited the Casa Grande ruins in 1883-1884 and reported on its condition and probable significance.
3. Veteran of both the War of 1812 and the Mexican War of 1846 visited and made notes of what he saw
5. Diagnosed with tuberculosis, he moved to Arizona for his health in 1900. The following year, he accepted a position with the U. S. General Land Office to be the first permanent, on-site custodian at the Casa Grande Ruins reserve.
7. The first European to visit the large Hohokam ruin which he named "Casa Grande" (Great House).
9. Leader of an early expedition that passed by the Great House. He became the Governor of New Mexico in 1777. (New Mexico was NOT a US state, appointment was from the Viceroy of New Spain)
