Shackleford Banks Horse Herd Update July 2, 2008

The herd numbers 126 with the newest addition, a filly, born in late June. The nine foals born this year include 6 females and 3 males.

Rain has been sporadic this summer, causing water holes to fluctuate. When one source becomes less available, the horses in that area move to drink elsewhere.
