



**Blue Blazes Whiskey Still Trail** – is accessed from the gravel parking lot across from the visitor center. The trailhead begins just before the wooden bridge at the entrance of the gravel parking lot.

Interpretive trailside signs explore stream ecology and the whiskey still industry ending at an actual whiskey still. Although no longer in use, during June and September, whiskey making talks are given and the process of distilling whiskey is examined (see calendar of events for information on dates and times).

This trail truly invokes the excitement and thrill of moonshining, yet gives visitors a better understanding of the hard work and ingenuity it took to survive in the mountains.
