HISTORY

Armand Winfield earned his undergraduate degree in museum studies from Franklin and Marshall College, PA in 1941. It was during his time as Assistant Curator at the school's museum of anthropology that Winfield gained an interest in the art of museum preservation and conservation. While he was still attending F&M, he took part in the 1940 Chaco Canyon field school as well as the 1939 Jemez Mountain field school in New Mexico. This experience gave him invaluable field experience as well as new ideas on how to preserve and excavate artifacts in the field.

After he finished his undergraduate study, Winfield was immediately accepted to the UNM Graduate School of Anthropology. However, his studies at UNM were cut short when he was drafted into military service in 1943.

After his return, Winfield enrolled in the Master's program in Sociology and Anthropology at Washington University in St. Louis, MO, where he renewed his interest in museum preservation techniques. His research yielded innovative new methods of plaster/plastic casting of objects for preservation. Later he founded his own plastics consulting company and made a name for himself as a custom jewelry designer and architecture critic.
