### **Firewood Permits Available for Chiricahua National Monument**

Due to recent fire hazard materials reduction in the monument, 20 firewood permits will be available on a first-come first-served basis on Saturday, October 29, 2011. The cost of the permit is \$25.00 and it can only be purchased in person at the visitor center with a personal or cashier's check issued to National Park Service. The visitor center is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The permit will allow the holder to gather one pick-up load of firewood from pre-established stacks. Due to the narrow, dirt road where the wood is located, no vehicles with trailers will be allowed into the loading site. Permit days may be cancelled or delayed due to inclement weather.
