 - g. Pocahontas
2. Match the artifacts with the person from the Voices of Jamestown
 - a. Anthony Johnson- **pipe**
 - b. Rachel Stanton- **chicken bone**
 - c. Lech- **glass piece**
 - d. Joan Peirce- **thimble**
 - e. John Rolfe- **coin- sixpence**
 - f. Samuel Collier- **dice**
 - g. Pocahontas - **pottery shards(English and Native American for comparison)**
3. Examine the Land Contract and Servitude Contract on "parchment" paper.
 - a. Discuss why these were written and what value they had to the owner and the person effected.
