



## What is Algae?

### Student guide

On your outing today your job is to be searching for algae. Remember algae can be different colors. Please be careful, watch your step, the rocks can be slippery. Respect the animals and organisms living around the rocks. Use the [Acadia National Park's Intertidal Flora Guide](#) to help you figure out what you are seeing.
