If accessing the monument in vehicles shorter than 37 feet in length, this permit application is not required, however, you will need an educational fee waiver. Educational fee waivers are administered and processed by the Inyo National Forest. Attach additional sheets, if necessary, to provide required information.** You will be notified of the disposition of the application and the necessary steps to secure your final permit. Pursuant to the 2010 NPS Interim Regulations, parks have up to 10 days to process a fully executed application that seeks to engage in a demonstration or the sale or distribution of printed matter.
