Update: As of 2012, Cliff Park Inn and Golf Course are closed and a new lessee is being sought for the property.

Atop the Milford Cliffs sits the newest addition to the recreation area, 450-acre Cliff Park. The Buchanan family owned this parcel from 1803, and operated Cliff Park Inn, an 1820 farmhouse located at the northern end of the property, from 1900 until last year.

The newly-renovated inn now has 14 rooms and 3 restaurants, and is the only lodging in the recreation area besides campgrounds. A 9-hole PGA golf course opened to the public in 1913, and has been continually expanded. The Inn and golf course will operate year-round under a lease to Jamie and Yvonne Klausmann.
