Joanna Kidd is a sculptor, printmaker and video artist. After graduating from Dartmouth College with a BA in Philosophy and Cognitive Science, she studied Printmaking and Sculpture at San Francisco State University from 2000 to 2002. She graduated from the Accademia di Belle Arti in Florence Italy with a degree in Sculpture in 2007, and from the same school with an advanced degree in Visual Art and Multimedia Techniques in 2010. Recent solo exhibitions include *Joanna Kidd: Ink Blots and Other Ink Forms* at the UC Davis Buehler Alumni and Visitors Center Gallery in Davis (California) in 2012 and *Joanna Kidd* at the John Natsoulas Gallery in Davis (California) in 2010. Other recent exhibitions include *Startpoint* at the Luigi Pecci Museum of Contemporary Art in Prato (Italy) and *24 Sata Umetnosti* at Festival Savremene Umetnosti in Belgrade (Serbia) in 2010; *Proof* at Southern Exposure in San Francisco and *Set in Concrete* at Chic Art Fair in Paris (France) in 2011; *Duration* at Gallery Route One in Point Reyes (California) and *Momentum* at Gallery 825 in Los Angeles in 2012.

“I work in sculpture, printmaking, painting and video installation, and am interested in bridging the boundary between these different media, as well as exploring the connection between verbal and visual communication. My work has been strongly influenced by the experience of learning to communicate in another culture and being without words. My most recent work deals with the themes of perception and interpersonal communication. The goal is to create visual representations of inner emotional states with work that provokes an immediate emotional response”.
