



**Fort Smith National Historic Site** is accepting applications for the Youth Conservation (YCC) program to work five (5) days per week for a minimum of eight weeks. The program will begin when school ends. Pay is \$7.25 per hour. Work hours will consist of eight (8) hours per day with a half-hour lunch, or 40 hours per week. Enrollees will work with park resource management or maintenance staff on a variety of tasks.

You will need your own transportation to and from work. Positions will be filled by young men and women. To be eligible to apply, you must be at least 15 years of age and cannot reach your 19<sup>th</sup> birthday during the term of employment. Tentative dates of work are June 15 through August 9. You must also be a permanent resident of the United States and have a social security card.
