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(5303) J____, R.J. Private. U.S. vol. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4673B) Jackson, Andrew Thomas Cook. 2-cl U.S. Navy. Enlisted 26 Feb. 1919. Discharged 8 Feb., 1921. Died 30 Oct., 1931.

(5146) Jackson, Benjamin F. Private. Co.K, 73 PA. Enlisted at Philadelphia. Mustered in 25 Jul., 1861 for three years. Died 17 May, 1863 of wounds recieved at Chancellorsville 3 May, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Brooks's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4687H) Jackson, Burdell Private. 21 Aviation Squad. Va. Died 1 Feb, 1944.

(3366) Jackson, Charles Corporal. Co.I, 35 PA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield (ROH).

(6699) Jackson, Henry Howell Private. 5 Regt. U.S.M.C. Discharged 13 Aug., 1919. Died 5 Nov, 1930.

(4678G) Jackson, John T. Sergeant.^{4th} B&S Det. Inf. Enlisted 30 July, 1918. Discharged 28 July, 1919. Died 14 July, 1934.

(3526) Jackson, Lewis C. Private. Co.I, 17 Mich. Age - 18. Enlisted at Dundee on 31 Jul., 1862 for three years. Mustered in 16 Aug., 1862. Wounded in action at Antietam, MD, 17 Sep., 1862. Died of disease at Falmouth 13 Jan., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Wallace's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2246) Jackson, William H. Private. Co.E, 10 NJ. Mustered in 5 Jan., 1864 for three years. Died at First Division, Sixth Army Corps Hospital 16 May, 1864 of wounds recieved in action at Galt House, VA, 14 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Allsops Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4884) Jacobs, George Private. Co.F, 11 U.S.A. Age - 18. Originally a farmer from Marion. Enlisted 21 Feb., 1862 for three years. Killed in action 10 May, 1864 near Spotsylvania Court House (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5589) James, Henry Private. Co.C, 7 Mich. Cav. Died 2 May, 1863. Originally buried at Fitzhugh's farm, Stafford (ROH)

(6678) James, Jesse R. Private. 153 U.S.M.C. Died 28 Sep, 1921

(1671) James, Richard J. Private. Batt.A, 1MD. Mustered in 22 Jan., 1862. Killed at the Battle of Fredericksburg 13 Dec., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6722) James, Wilbur Private. Co.I, 38 Regt. C.A.C. US Regular Inf. Va. Enlisted 29 Feb., 1932. Discharged 23 March, 1935. Died 6 Dec., 1935.

(3444) Jameson, James Private. Co.D, 3ME. Age - 24. Formerly an upholsterer. Born in New York City. Mustered in at Augusta, ME 4 Jun., 1861 for three years. Detailed as provost, Division HQ from Sep., 1862 to Feb., 1864. Killed 12 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill of a gunshot wound through the neck (NARA). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4163) Janvier, John 1st Sergeant. Co.K, 2 Del. Age - 28. Enlisted 9 Sep., 1861 at Wilmington, for three years. Mustered in as a Sergeant, 7 Oct., 1861. Absent sick in hospital Aug. to Nov., 1862. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at the Battle of the Wilderness (NARA). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(280) Jarvis, Charles F. Private. Co.C, 1 MA H. Art. Age - 24. Occ - Shoemaker. Res - Lynn. Enlisted and Mustered 5 Jul., 1861 for three years (SR). Killed 19 May, 1864. Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3251) Jarvis, William Corporal. Co.G, 95 PA. Enlisted at Philadelphia and mustered in as a Private 30 Sept., 1861 for three years. Promoted to Corporal Nov. 1863. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5325) Jebb, Phillip J. W. Sergeant. Co.F, 10 NJ. Age - 24. Occ - Blacksmith. Born - Patterson, NJ. Mustered in 13 Dec., 1861 as a Corporal for three years. Promoted to Sergeant 1 May, 1862. Re-enlisted as veteran 3 Jan., 1864. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4028) Jemison, Edward E. (Original roster has Jameson) Lieutenant. 1 NJ Cav. Age - 25. Husband of **Mary Jane Jemison (Barnart)**, and father of **Abigail, Gardiner, and Albert**. Enlisted 13 Aug., 1861 for three years. Mustered in as a Sergeant, Co.E, 20 Aug., 1861. Promoted to Orderly Sergeant 1 Jan., 1862, and First Sergeant 12 Jan., 1862. Promoted to 2nd Lieutenant 8 Oct., 1862, and mustered into Co.D, 24 Oct., 1862 at Washington, D.C.. Promoted to 1st Lieutenant 12 Jun., 1863, and mustered into Co.I 1 Jul., 1863. Killed in action 27 Nov., 1863 at Mine Run, VA on the Plank Road between Fredricksburg and Gordonsville, of gunshot wound through the heart. He was buried behind a nearby brick church (NARA). ROH states originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania.

(3359) Jenkins, Daniel E. Captain. Co.E, 51 NY. Age - 20. Enlisted 19 Aug., 1861 at New York City for three years. Mustered in as a Sergeant 9 Sep., 1861. Commissioned 2nd Lieutenant 12 Dec., 1862 (1861?), with rank from 10 Sept., 1862 (1861?). Promoted 1st Lieutenant 12 Dec., 1862 with rank from 1 Nov., 1862. Promoted to Captain, Co.H, 30 Mar., 1863, with rank from 14 Mar., 1863. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6677) Jenkins, Robert L. Private. Co.K, 116 U.S. 29 Div. Died 15 Oct. 1918.

(1846) Jennison, Sewell A (SR has Jamison) Corporal. Co.E, 4 MI. Age - 23. Res - Hillsdale. Enlisted 20 Jun., 1861 at Adrian for three years. Mustered in as a Corporal (SR). Complained of Dropsy and was admitted to Stoneman Switch 1st Division, 5th Corps on 10 Mar. and died 30 Mar., 1863 (HR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5638) Jesson, Charles (FVC has Jurson) Private. 12 OH Art. Age - 18. Enlisted 8 Jun., 1861 for three years into Co. C, 25 OH Vol.. Transferred to 12 OH Art. 17 Mar, 1862. Died 11 May, 1863 at Aquia Creek (SR). Originally buried at Tump Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(6742) Jett, Admol L. Private First Class. Co.K, 318 Inf. 80 Div. U.S. Marine Corps. Enlisted 18 Sept., 1917. Discharged 3 June 1919. Died 26 Nov, 1940. Jett's son is buried in the same grave with his name on the reverse side of the stone.

(6742) Jett, Admol Glorial Corporal. 21 Marines, 3rd v. Fought in WW II in Bougainville and Guam. He sacrificed his life on Iwo Jima when he deliberately exposed himself to draw enemy fire in order to locate enemy gun positions. Died only after calling back directions which enabled Marine gunners to score a direct hit on an enemy position. Died March 1, 1945. Buried in same grave with his father.

(4600) Jobs, James S. Private. CoD, 33 NY. Age - 21. Enlisted 25 Aug, 1862 at Rochester for three years. Mustered 17 Oct, 1862. Died of disease 22 Dec (FVC has 23 Dec.), 1862 (ROH) in camp at White Oak Church (SR). Originally buried at Lee's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(504) Jobs, Joshua (SR has Jobbs, Josiah) Sergeant. Co.C, 61 PA. Age - 22. Occ - glass blower. Res - Fayetteville Co. Enlisted 1 Aug, 1861 at Pittsburg for three years. Mustered 31 Oct, 1861 and went to Camp Wilkins. Promoted Corporal Jan. or Feb, 1862. Wounded at the Battle of Fair Oaks Station 31 May, 1862. Promoted Sergeant 6 May, 1863. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864.(NARA). Originally buried at Laurel Hill, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(741) Jock, Alexander Private. Co.B, 17 MI. Age - 18. Res - Mt. Clemens. Enlisted in Co.F, 19 Jul, 1862 at Detroit for three years. Mustered 26 Aug, 1862. Transferred to Co.B, 26 Aug, 1862. Killed at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Harris Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3362) Johnson, A.W. Private. Co.E, 45 PA. Mustered in 26 Feb, 1864 for three years. Killed 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5639) Johnson, Benjamin F. Private. Co.D, 64 NY. Age - 32. Enlisted at Rushford and mustered 14 Aug, 1862 for three years. Wounded 3 May, 1863 at Chancellorsville and died of his wounds 7 May (FVC has 6 May), 1863 at Aquia Creek (SR). Originally buried at Tump Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(4887) Johnson, Charles C. Lieutenant. Co.A, 155 PA. Mustered 23 Aug, 1862 as a Sergeant for three years. Commissioned 1st Lieutenant (not mustered) 10 Apr, 1863. Killed in action at Laurel Hill 8 May, 1864. Brother of **Lt. Edward P. Johnston** (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(2087) Johnson, Enos (FVC has Jhonson) Private. U.S. Vol. Died 1863. Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3827) Johnson, John W. (FVC has Jhonson) Private. Co. G, 1 U.S.S.S. Res - Madison, WI. Enlisted 3 March, 1862. Wounded 27 Nov., 1863 at Locust Grove, Va. Died 30 Nov., 1863, of wounds (SR). Originally buried at Lee's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4799) Johnson, George W. Private. Co.D, 26 NJ. Enlisted 3 Sept., 1862 for nine months. Mustered in 18 Sept., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at camp 26 Mar, 1863 (SR) Originally buried at Ball's Farm, Stafford (ROH)

Johnson, J.W. (see Jhonson)

(5064) Johnson, Jacob B. Sergeant. Co.G, 6 NJ. Enlisted 9 Aug, 1861 for three years. Mustered in as a Private 26 Aug, 1861. Promoted to Corporal 26 Aug, 1861, and Sergeant 10 Sept., 1862. Died from disease at Regimental Field Hospital near Falmouth 5 Jan, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(5754) Johnson, James Private. Co.H, 147 NY. Age - 19. Occ - Farmer. Born - West Monroe. Enlisted 30 Aug, 1862 for three years. Mustered 23 Sep, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at Regimental Field Hospital at Falmouth 10 Jan, 1863 (NARA). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(705) Johnson, John Private. Co.E, 143 (FVC has 137, but all research states 143) PA. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania. (ROH)

(5435) Johnson, Mathias (also Matthew) Private. Co.F, 137 PA. Mustered in 15 Sep, 1862. Died at Belle Plain, VA 1 Mar, 1863. (SR) Originally buried at Pratt's Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(2965) Johnson, Richard P. Corporal. Co.A, 3 MI. Age - 25. Res - Kent Co. Enlisted 13 May, 1861 at Grand Rapids for three years. Mustered 10 Jun, 1861. Killed in action at Chancellorsville 3 May, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Chancellorsville (ROH).

(4533) Johnson, Seth F. Captain. Co.I, 44 NY. Age - 25. Enlisted 8 Aug, 1861 at Albany for three years. Mustered in as a Sergeant, Co.C, 30 Aug, 1861. Promoted to First Sergeant, 1 Jan, 1862, and Quartermaster Sergeant 1 Jun, 1862. Promoted to 1st Lieutenant Co.G, 18 Dec, 1862, commissioned 25 Feb, 1863. Mustered into Co.G, 23 Mar, 1863. Promoted to Captain 28 Oct, 1863 with rank from 9 Oct, 1863. Killed in action 5 May, 1864 at Wilderness (SR).

(1706) Johnson, Thomas Corporal. Co.D, 12 NJ. Enlisted 23 Aug, 1862 for three years. Mustered in as a private 4 Sept., 1862. Promoted to Corporal 1 Jan, 1863. Died of Typhoid Fever at a Hospital near Falmouth 26 Mar, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Mrs. Coon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3368) Johnson, Thomas Private. Co.B, 27 MI. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4358) Johnson, Thomas Corporal. Co.K, 53 PA. Mustered in as a Corporal 22 Dec, 1863. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). vet. Originally buried at McCoull's farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3402) Johnson, William Private. Co.A, 26 PA. Age 18. Occ - Bricklayer. Res - Philadelphia. Enlisted 5 May, 1861 at Philadelphia for three years. Mustered 27 May, 1861. Died at Chancellorsville 5 May, 1863 of wounds recieved in action (NARA). Originally buried at Mrs. Smith's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3721) Johnson, William Private. Co.B, 4 VT. Age - 27. Res - West Fairlee. Enlisted 13 Sep, 1862. Mustered 22 Sep, 1862. Died of disease 30 Dec, 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Hansborough's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(604) Johnson, William H. Private. Co.G, 1 MA H. Art. Age - 21. Occ - Cordwainer. Res - Marblehead. Mustered in 5 Jul, 1861 at Fort Warren, MA for three years. Re-enlisted 3 Dec, 1863. Killed at Spotsylvania 19 May, 1864 (SR). HR states he died 19 May near Shady Grove. Originally

buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH) Has letters at Chatham, vol.70. Diary dates 22 Apr to 5 May, 1864 in which talks of being reviewed by **Grant and Meade** and the battles of Fredericksburg and the Wilderness.

(1339) **Johnson, William M.** Sergeant. Co. B., 17 MI. Enlisted at Manchester, 26 Aug., 1862 for three years. Served as color-bearer. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6658) **Johnson, William P.** Private. Co.H, 20 PA Cav. Died 3 Nov, 1909.

(4887) **Johnston, Chas.** (see **Johnson, C.C.**)

(3405) **Jollimore, William** Private. Co.F, 1 MA. Age - 26. Occ - Brushmaker. Res - Charlestown. Enlisted 8 Aug, 1862, and mustered in 13 Aug, 1862. Killed 3 May, 1863 at Chancellorsville (SR). Originally buried at Mrs. Smith's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(1707) **Jones,___** . Captain. 6 Army Corps. Died 1862. Originally buried at Freedmans Hospital, Fredericksburg (ROH)

(2352) **Jones, Charles H.** Private. Co.B, 12 NH. Age - 25. Res - Alton. Enlisted 21 Aug, 1862, and mustered in 30 Aug, 1862. Died of disease 17 Dec, 1862 at Potomac Creek, VA (SR). Originally buried at Primmer's Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(6049) **Jones, David** Private. Co.D, 16 NY. Age - 21. Enlisted 1 May, 1861 at DeKalb for two years. Mustered in 15 May, 1861. Wounded 14 Sep, 1862 at Crampton's Pass, MD. Died of wounds 20 Dec, 1862 at White Oak Church (SR). Originally buried at White Oak Church, Stafford (ROH)

(4715) **Jones, Evan** Private. Co.F, 46 PA. Mustered 16 Sep, 1861. Died at Stafford Court House 19 Feb, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Stafford Court House, Stafford (ROH)

(1653) **Jones, Ezekiel** Corporal. Co.H, 9 NH. Age - 27. Res - Canterbury. Enlisted 18 Aug, 1862 for three years. Mustered in 21 Aug, 1862 as a Private. Died of disease 3 Dec, 1862 at Falmouth (SR) Originally buried at Phillips Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(5464) **Jones, Greenlief T.** (NARA has **Jones, Greenfield T.**) Private. Co.F, 16 ME. Enlisted 29 Jul, 1862 at South Darmouth for three years. Mustered in 14 Aug, 1862 at Augusta. Died 30 Jan, 1863, at Hospital at Windmill Point of chronic dysentary contracted on or about 13 Dec, 1862 from exposure before and after the battle of Fredericksburg (NARA) Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).

(1126) **Jones, John F.** Private. Co.E, 28 NJ. Enlisted 1 Sep, 1862 for nine months. Mustered in 22 Sep, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at camp near Falmouth 6 Feb, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at O'Bannon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3780) **Jones, Joseph** Private. Co. H, 109 NY. Age - 36. Enlisted at Washington, D.C. Mustered-in on 1 Aug., 1863, for three years. Killed in action 6 May, 1864 at Wilderness (SR). Originally buried on the Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3823) **Jones, Joseph** Corporal. Co.B, 7 IN. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Mathew's Farm, North Anna River (ROH)

(4176) **Jones, R.** Private. Co.B, 14 IN. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Center Branch Hospital, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(2449) **Jones, Ransom E.** Corporal. Co.H, 9 NH. Age - 21. Res - Lancaster. Enlisted 23 Dec, 1863 and mustered in as a Private. Appointed Corporal. Killed 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(283) **Jones, Sylvanus** Private. Co.E, 1 MA H. Art. Age - 27. Occ - Teamster. Res - Methuen Enlisted and mustered 5 Mar, 1862. Wounded at Spotsylvania 19 May, 1864 and died of wounds 1 Jun, 1864 at Washington, D.C. (NARA). Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(2846) **Jones, Thomas** Private. Co.I, 61 NY. Age - 24. Enlisted 3 Sep, 1862 at New York City for three years. Mustered in 19 Sep, 1862. Died of disease 22 Dec, 1862 in hospital at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH)

(2448) **Jones, William** 1st Sergeant. Co.A, 73 NY. Age - 25. Born - Jan. 1836 in Ireland. Enlisted 25 May, 1861 at New York City for three years. Mustered in as a Private, Co.C, 8 Oct, 1861. Transferred to Co. A, 1 Sep, 1861. Promoted to Sergeant (no date). Re-enlisted as a veteran 30 Dec, 1863. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Awarded the **Medal of Honor** for service at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864, issued posthumously on 1 Dec, 1864, for capture of the flag of 65 VA infantry CSA (note: there was no 65 VA at Spotsylvania). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1406) **Jordan, Hiram** Corporal. Co.G, 72 PA. Mustered 25 Oct, 1861. Killed at Falmouth 7 Dec., 1862 (SR). Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3828) **Joslin, Herbert** Private. Co.G, 21 MA. Age - 18. Occ - Bootmaker. Res - Bellingham. Enlisted 12 Aug, 1861 and mustered in 23 Aug, 1861. Re-enlisted 1 Jan, 1864. Killed 6 May, 1864 at the Wilderness (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2516) **Joslyn, Edwin** Private. Co.E, 2 U.S.S.S. Died 1864. Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH)

(2070) **Jourdan, Lewis** Private. U.S. vol. Died 13 Dec, 1862. Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(3559) **Juddy, George H.** Private. Co.C, 4 NJ. Enlisted 30 Sep, 1861 for three years. Re-enlisted 26 Dec, 1863. Killed in action at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR) Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4175) **Judge, John** Private. Co.B, 82 NY. Age - 21. Enlisted for three years and mustered in 15 Apr, 1864. Killed 14 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Center Branch Hospital, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5944) **Judkin, Perrin C.** Lieutenant. Co.G, 1 U.S.S.S. Killed in action at the battle of Todd's Tavern 8 May, 1864 (Reg) Originally buried at Stuarts Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(3351) **Justice, George C.** Lieutenant. Co.A, 15 NJ. Mustered in as First Sergeant. Promoted 2nd Lieutenant 18 Mar, 1863, and 1st Lieutenant 27 Jul, 1863. Killed at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
