PRESIDIO COASTAL TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM Historic Forest Management OCTOBER 18—NOVEMBER 19

This forest management project will improve the health of the forest stand, help restore the historic landscape, and facilitate the future installation of the Golden Gate and Pacific Overlooks, Presidio Coastal Trail, and Lincoln Boulevard bicycle lanes. Starting the tree work now will allow us to complete the work before raptor and migratory bird nesting season and the onset of winter rains. This project is part of a comprehensive trail improvement program made possible by a generous challenge grant from the Evelyn and Walter Haas, Jr. Fund, and thanks to contributions made by donors to the Presidio Trails program and Parks Conservancy members.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Trees identified for pruning or removal included those that are:

- Within the footprint of the trail, overlooks or Lincoln Boulevard Roadway and Bikeways Improvement project
- Dead or diseased
- Hazards to visitor safety
- Beyond the historic forest footprint
