

# Grand Canyon National Park Environmental Education Program Travel Grant Application

The Grand Canyon National Park Environmental Education program will award Travel Grants each school year. Travel Grants will be awarded based on financial need and on a first-come, first-serve basis until funds have been depleted for the year's grant cycle. This money has been made possible through generous grants to the park by the Grand Canyon Association and the Toyota Foundation.

In order to be eligible for a grant, schools must be scheduled for one of our curriculum-based programs and have at least 50% of their students on the free or reduced lunch program. Travel Grants are to cover transportation costs only.
