



## Regular Programs:

### Beginner's Nature Photography

Learn the proper camera setting to capture images of flying birds, small animals, and close-ups of flowers. *Reservations required due to limited space: meet in the Visitor Center.*

### Bird Watching

Grab your field guides and binoculars. Then join other birdwatchers to search for migratory and resident birds in Great Falls Park. *Meet rain or shine in the Visitor Center Courtyard.*

### Falls Walk

Visit the Overlooks with a Park Ranger and learn about the park, the Potomac River, and the Patowmack Canal. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### Ranger Rendezvous

Do you have any questions about Great Falls Park? This is your chance to learn more about the park and the river. *Meet at Overlook #3.*

## Special Programs:

### Amphibian Life Cycles

Frogs and Toads are not the same species, however many people seem to group them together as one. Join this ranger led walk to explore the differences and similarities of two species commonly found in Great Falls Park. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### A Walk Down Lovers' Lane

Not so long ago people came to Great Falls by trolley, viewed the river from a tower, took a walk down Lovers' Lane, and tried to grab a brass ring on the carousel. Join a ranger to catch a glimpse of Great Falls' romantic past. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### Aqueduct Dam

The Washington Aqueduct has been providing the public water supply for the metropolitan DC area since 1864. Hike with a ranger to take a look at this National Historic Landmark and learn about its operation. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### Be Aware, Be Safe

Make sure your park visit is a happy one! Walk with a ranger to learn about some key safety tips for recreating in Great Falls Park. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### Canal Walk

Join this ranger walk to discover George Washington's dream canal, and learn about its impact on early America. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### Discovery Hike

Hike with a ranger upstream of the falls to discover what wonders Great Falls Park has to offer. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### The Eagle has Landed

Join a ranger in the upper parking lot for this bird watching program. You might catch a glimpse at our resident bald eagles. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### The Leaves in the Trees

As spring advances, the buds of trees have sprung into leaves. Join a ranger for a short walk through the picnic area to identify different trees using their leaves and other helpful clues. *Meet at the Visitor Center's Information Desk.*

### Wildflower Walk

Join this exciting and educational walk to learn how to identify wildflowers and the role they play in the ecosystem of Great Falls Park. *Meet in the Visitor Center's courtyard.*
