Values are:</p> <p>Present in Park: Species' occurrence in park is documented and assumed to be extant.</p> <p>Probably Present: Park is within species' range and contains appropriate habitat. Documented occurrences of the species in the adjoining region of the park give reason to suspect that it probably occurs within the park. The degree of probability may vary within this category, including species that range from common to rare.</p> <p>Unconfirmed: Included for the park based on weak ("unconfirmed record") or no evidence, giving minimal indication of the species' occurrence in the park.</p>
Abundance	<p>Abundant: Animals: May be seen daily, in suitable habitat and season, and counted in relatively large numbers. Plants: Large number of individuals; wide ecological amplitude or occurring in habitats covering a large portion of the park.</p> <p>Common: Animals: May be seen daily, in suitable habitat and season, but not in large numbers. Plants: Large numbers of individuals predictably occurring in commonly encountered habitats but not those covering a large portion of the park.</p> <p>Uncommon: Animals: Likely to be seen monthly in appropriate season/habitat. May be locally common. Plants: Few to moderate numbers of individuals; occurring either sporadically in commonly encountered habitats or in uncommon habitats.</p> <p>Rare: Animals: Present, but usually seen only a few times each year. Plants: Few individuals, usually restricted to small areas of rare habitat.</p> <p>Occasional: Occurs in the park at least once every few years, but not necessarily every year. Applicable to animals only.</p>
Residency	<p>Current residency classification for each animal species in each park. Park Status as above must be either "Present" or "Probably Present".</p> <p>Breeder: Population reproduces in the park.</p> <p>Resident: A significant population is maintained in the park for more than two months each year, but it is not known to breed there.</p> <p>Migratory: Migratory species that occurs in park approximately two months or less each year and does not breed there.</p> <p>Vagrant: Park is outside of the species' usual range.</p>
Nativity	<p>Nativity classification for each species in each park. Park Status as defined above must be either "Present" or "Probably Present".</p> <p>Native: The species is native to the park (either endemic or indigenous), or if the Park Status is "Probably Present" as defined above, the species would be native to the park if it were eventually confirmed in the park.</p> <p>Non-Native: The species is not native to the park (neither endemic nor indigenous), or if the Park Status is "Probably Present" as defined above, the species would not be native to the park if it were eventually confirmed in the park. Persistent plant populations (as defined below) that reproduce are also considered non-native.</p>
