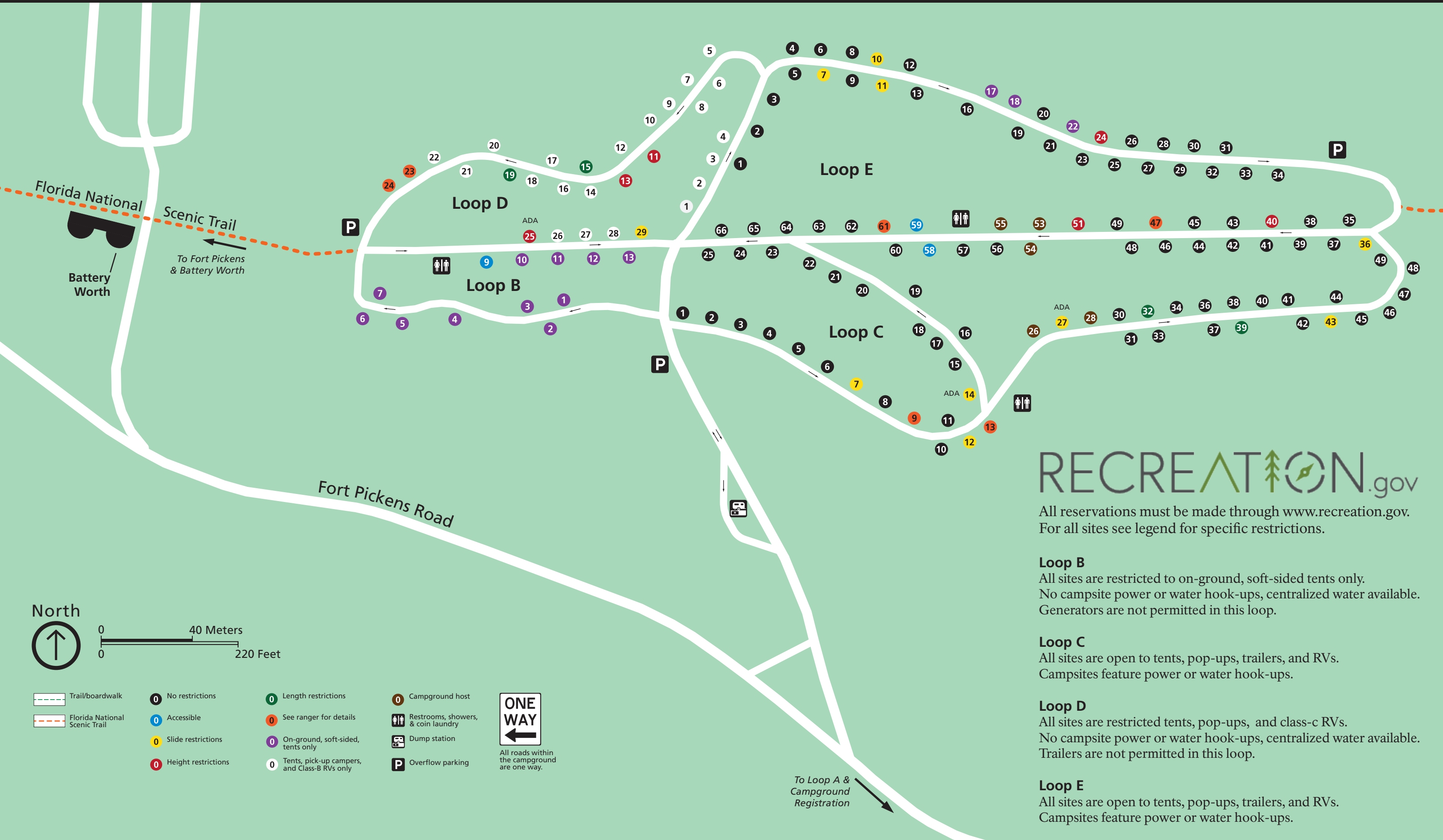

Loop B

All sites are restricted to on-ground, soft-sided tents only.
No campsite power or water hook-ups, centralized water available.
Generators are not permitted in this loop.

Loop C

All sites are open to tents, pop-ups, trailers, and RVs.
Campsites feature power or water hook-ups.

Loop D

All sites are restricted tents, pop-ups, and class-c RVs.
No campsite power or water hook-ups, centralized water available.
Trailers are not permitted in this loop.

Loop E

All sites are open to tents, pop-ups, trailers, and RVs.
Campsites feature power or water hook-ups.

Check-in & Check-out Information

Campground office hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Check-out time is 11 a.m. Late check-outs are subject to another night's fee.

Parking

No more than two vehicles may be parked on each site at any one time (car/trailer, car/RV, and car/car). Additional vehicles must park in the overflow parking area. Do not park vehicles in unoccupied sites.

Fires

Fires are only permitted in grills and fire rings only. Dead wood which has already fallen to the ground may be collected for campfires. Do not use drift wood. Please do not build large fires during windy or dry conditions. Burning of trash and using chainsaws is prohibited. Do not cut tree limbs or other vegetation.

Pets

All pets must be on a leash, not to exceed six feet in length. Pets are not allowed on any beach or inside any structure. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Pets are not permitted to make excessive noise.

Waste Water

Dumping grey-water or sewage on the ground or in the restrooms is prohibited. A dump station is provided. Do not wash vehicles.

Noise

Please be courteous to others; quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Getting Around

The Florida National Scenic Trail runs through the Fort Pickens Campground connecting the historic district to Fort Pickens and Langdon Beach. The trail offers an excellent way to get around the area on foot or bicycle.

Other Information

- No mail service available.
- Camping permitted only in designated campsites.
- Only one RV and one tent, or two tents, with a max of eight persons, is allowed per campsite.
- Campsites must be physically occupied or the permit will be revoked.
- Group campgrounds are for tents only. Max occupancy is 40 people. No pets allowed.
- Equipment left unattended overnight is subject to impound.
- Do not hang anything on the electrical boxes, trees, signs, or poles to include hammocks and tents.

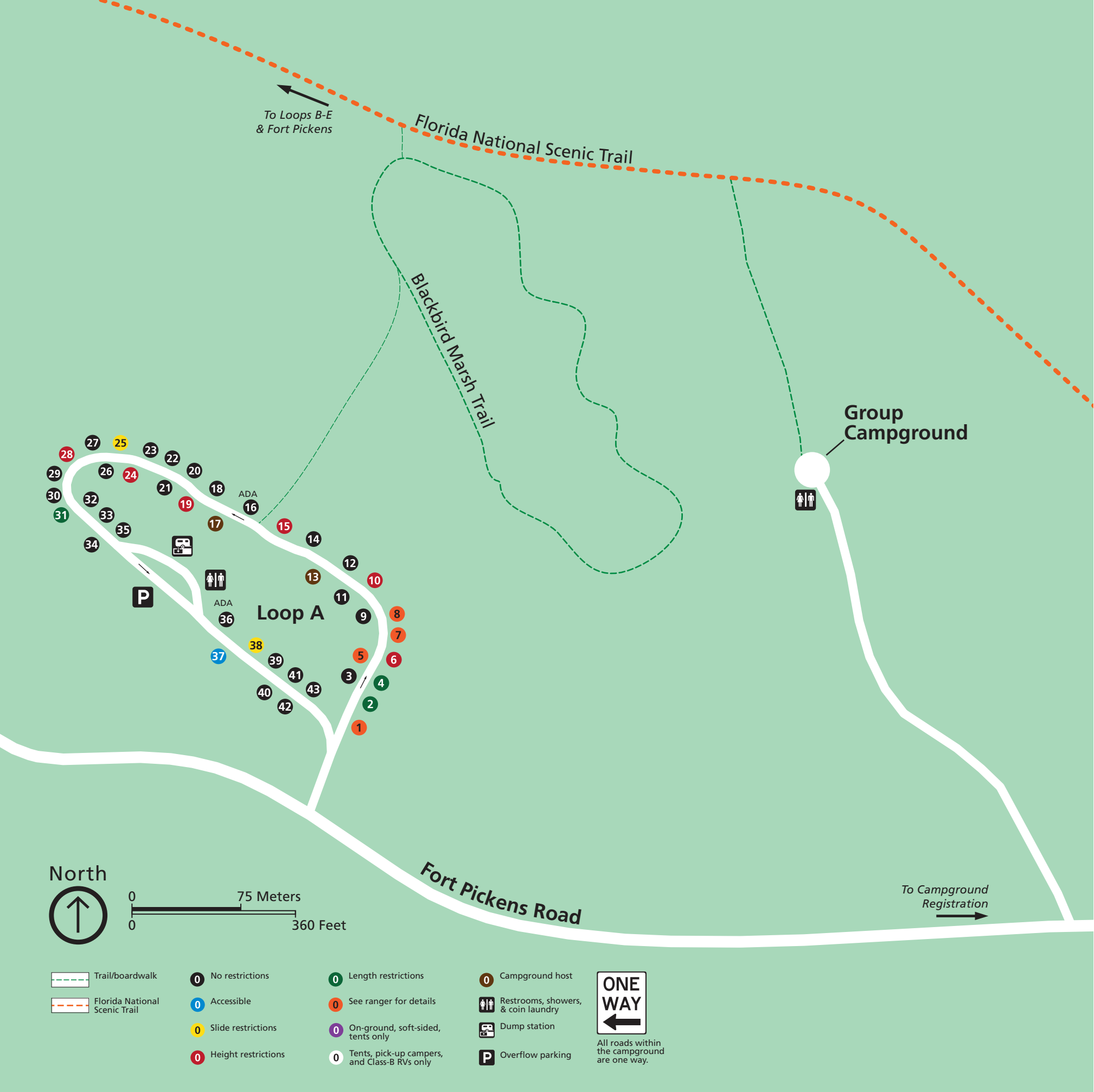
Road Flooding & Emergency Evacuations
