


#### GEORGE WASHINGTON MEMORIAL PARKWAY OVERVIEW

- Great Falls to Mount Vernon, includes the Clara Barton Parkway
- Designed for recreational driving
- Listed on the National Register of Historic Places
- Links sites that commemorate important episodes in American history
- > Preserves habitat for local wildlife
- More than a parkway!

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### **REHABILITATION PROJECT OVERVIEW**



- Four-lane scenic historic parkway
  Approximately 7.6 miles of the roadway between Spout Run to Interstate 495/Capital Beltway
- Fairfax and Arlington Counties
- > 128 water drainage outlets along the project corridor
- > 10 bridges spanning waterways or existing roadways

### **REHABILITATION OVERVIEW**

Replace asphalt pavement



Modify the Route 123 interchange



Lengthen entrance/exit lanes at some interchanges

Reconstruct and repair stone walls and roadside barriers



Replace and repair drainage systems




Rehabilitate historic overlooks and reopen historic parkway views



# **ROADWAY SCHEDULE**

I-495 TO ROUTE 123 / CHAIN BRIDGE ROAD Fall 2022 – Fall 2025

ROUTE 123/CHAIN BRIDGE ROAD TO SPOUT RUN PARKWAY Fall 2023 – Fall 2025

Bridge work to occur on a variable schedule

Schedule is approximate and subject to change



# SELECTIVE REMOVAL OF TREES


- Select tree removal in median was necessary for temporary lanes
- Tree removal was minimized
- Tree replacement program







# TEMPORARY LANE WIDENING



- Temporary lane on the northbound side
- Milling machines, paving trucks, and other equipment will be used
- A barrier will be set for crew and motorist safety
- > 3-lane configuration
- > Public notification

# SOUTHBOUND RECONSTRUCTION




Temporary pavement to be used as the Southbound lane

# **REVERSIBLE LANES MORNING RUSH HOURS**

3-lane configuration maximizes work

 $\triangleright$ 

- Southbound lanes closed between I-495 and Route 123
- Temporary lane will always be a southbound lane
- Ground-mounted signs and VMS



# **REVERSIBLE LANES AFTERNOON RUSH HOURS**

- Two lanes will be open northbound between 2:45 p.m.
   7:00 p.m.
- Two lanes will be open southbound between 6:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.
- Weekend and night work anticipated
- Holiday Hours





# BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Separate schedule
  from roadway work
- Motorists will experience lane closures
- Most bridge work will occur under the bridge; it will not be visible to parkway visitors


