
GEORGE WASHINGTON MEMORIAL PARKWAY OVERVIEW

- Great Falls to Mount Vernon, includes the Clara Barton Parkway
- Designed for recreational driving
- Listed on the National Register of Historic
 Places
- Links sites that commemorate important episodes in American history
- Preserves habitat for local wildlife
- More than a parkway!

REHABILITATION PROJECT OVERVIEW



- Four-lane scenic historic parkway
- Approximately 7.6 miles of the roadway between Spout Run to Interstate 495/Capital Beltway
- Fairfax and Arlington Counties
- > 128 water drainage outlets along the project corridor
- 10 bridges spanning waterways or existing roadways

REHABILITATION OVERVIEW



Replace asphalt pavement



Lengthen entrance/exit lanes at some interchanges



Modify the Route 123 interchange



Reconstruct and repair stone walls and roadside barriers



Replace and repair drainage systems



Rehabilitate historic overlooks and re-open historic parkway views



ROADWAY SCHEDULE

I-495 TO ROUTE 123 / CHAIN BRIDGE ROAD Fall 2022 – Fall 2025

ROUTE 123/CHAIN BRIDGE ROAD TO SPOUT RUN PARKWAY Fall 2023 – Fall 2025

Bridge work to occur on an independent schedule from the roadway schedule

Schedule is approximate and subject to change based on weather and permitting

- Construction Started
- Temporary lane widening at from I-495 to Route 123

- Select tree removal in median and outfalls
- Visible to motorists and surrounding properties
- Tree removal was minimized
- Tree replacementprogram








NORTH PARKWAY REHABILITATION REVERSIBLE LANES

TEMPORARY LANE WIDENING



- Temporary lane on the northbound side
- Milling machines, paving trucks, and other equipment will be used
- A barrier will be set for crew and motorist safety
- 3-lane configuration
- Public notification

SOUTHBOUND RECONSTRUCTION



Temporary pavement to be used as the Southbound lane

REVERSIBLE LANES MORNING RUSH HOURS

GWMP Northbound

- **3-lane configuration** \triangleright maximizes work
 - SB lanes closed from I-495 and Route 123



- Temporary lane will > always be a southbound lane
- Right lane to exit > parkway; middle lane is through-lane
 - Ground-mounted signs and VMS

Southbound Lanes Reconstruction North of Route 123 PM Rush Hour (beginning Winter 2023)

> Reconstruct existing roadway, curb and drainage.

Work area varies

GWMP Southbound

Repair or remove and reconstruct existing stone masonry guardwall

Temporary lane dividers will separate the lanes. Drivers exiting the parkway before Spout Run will need to remain in the right lane


LATE 2023: NORTHBOUND RECONSTRUCTION




BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Separate schedule from roadway work
- Motorists will experience lane closures
- Most bridge work will occur under the bridge; it will not be visible to parkway visitors


