### **CATHERINE THOMAS BURNETT COLLECTION OF RIDGELY FAMILY PAPERS**

Collection of documents related to the Ridgely family at Hampton:

Note from Francis Brooke in London to Charles Ridgely, Junior in Baltimore, Jan. 15, 1765; re. sale of Negro Leonard to Nicholas Ridgely.

Receipt for payment from Nicholas Ridgely to Francis Brooke of L10 partial payment for Negro Leonard now in the possession of Capt. Charles Ridgely, Jan. 28, 1765; with subsequent acknowledgement by Greenbury Ridgely, March 18, 1768, on reverse.

Receipt for purchase by Mr. Mollison [on behalf of Capt. CR] from bookseller Nath'l. Young, London, Jan. 22, 1767; "C.R. - Johnson's Dictionary, 2 vols. Folio...L4/10/0;" mounted on small album page with clipping on reverse re. meeting of Centennial Grange about burning of barns, c. 1900.

Invoice from S. Gillespi to John Ridgely, May 22, 1848, for extensive list of repairing and varnishing of pieces of furniture in house.

Confirmation Certificate for Margaret Howard, signed by William Rollinson Whittingham, Bishop of Maryland, at Christ Church, Baltimore, March 7, 1857.

Invoice of accounts from J. C. Merillat to C. [Charles] Ridgely, Sept. 19, 1867 to Feb. 11, 1868; for board tuition, books, etc. for sons Otho and Howard.

Ledger pages (4) - C. [Charles] Ridgely of H.'s account with Johnston Bros. & Co., July 1870 - Jan. 1871; income and expenses.

Letters (3) from Johnston Bros. & Co. to C. [Charles] Ridgely of H. in England, 1871, re. investments and expenses.
