Guidelines for a Successful Visit to Hopewell Furnace:

- All programs involve walking outside and are offered rain or shine. Make sure participants are dressed appropriately for weather conditions.
- Arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled program. This will allow time for you to park, check-in, and use the restrooms.
- If you are delayed by traffic, etc., please call the park at 610-582-8773. If your group is delayed by 30 minutes or more, the park may need to switch your program to a self-guided tour.
- Make sure that the required number of adults are accompanying your group. The ratio for groups is 1:10. Chaperones are expected to be actively engaged in activities and to supervise students at all times. This ensures the safety of the visitors in the park, the historic structures, as well as the health and safety of the animals.
- Hopewell Furnace has a small bookstore where souvenirs may be purchased. No food is available for purchase, but you are welcome to pack your lunch and eat in the uncovered picnic area. Have students leave their lunch on the bus until lunchtime. Water fountains are located at the Visitor Center.
- To help preserve the natural and cultural resources of Hopewell Furnace, do not allow any collecting or removal of objects from the site. Do not allow climbing on wagons, fences, or other structures in the park. Treat the animals with kindness, and refrain from feeding the farm animals.
