EMERGENCY AND SAFETY INFORMATION

For any emergency or situation requiring immediate medical attention, dial 911.

For non-emergent situations inside park boundaries, call the National Park Service law enforcement dispatch office at 501-620-6739.

For non-emergent situations within the city limits outside the park boundary, call Hot Springs city police at 501-321-6789.

For non-emergent situations within the county outside the park boundary and the city limits, call the Garland County Sheriff's Office at 501-622-3660.

Participants should wear long pants and sturdy shoes, and should be prepared for a moderately strenuous hike. Remember to bring water, sunscreen, bug spray, and any medications you may need. Participants are also encouraged to bring and wear gloves to avoid poison ivy and other skin irritants. Where inventories occur near roadways, participants must obey pedestrian laws and regulations. Be safe out there, and let's BLITZ!
