


# Indiana Dunes

### Facilities

- 66 campsites: 53 conventional drive-in sites; (walk-in sites temporarily closed)
- Wheelchair accessible (3 sites) (#'s 15, 30, 41)
- Restrooms and showers (one in each loop)
- No electric hookups
- Some sites have limited recreational vehicle length

### Fees

**Automotive fee machine (AFM) requires a credit or debit card ONLY. No cash or checks accepted.** All sites are \$18.00 per night. Fees are reduced 50% for holders of Interagency Senior or Access passes. Sites are available on a first-come first-serve basis. No reservations.

### Season

Last Friday in April through third Sunday in October.

### Services

Lake Michigan is located 1.5 miles north of the campground. Several beach access points are within easy driving distance. Convenience stores and a gas station are located ¼ mile north of the campground at the intersection of U.S. 12 and Broadway. The Beverly Shores stop of the South Shore Railroad, with passenger service to Chicago and South Bend, is located on Broadway, ¼ mile north of the campground.

### Registration Information

- Camping is on a first-come, first-served basis. **No Reservations.**
- Register site as soon as you select it. Your registration slip along with your camping equipment shows others that this site is selected.
- Display your registration receipt on the campsite marker post.
- Check out is noon. Renewals must be completed at 9:00 am.  
Failure to do so may result in you forfeiting your site

### Camping Information

- Stays are limited to 14 days in a 30-day period.
- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 6 am. Please be considerate of others.
- All tents and equipment must be on the camping pad.
- All vehicles/R.V. campers must remain completely on the pavement.
- Pets must be attended, caged, or on a leash of a maximum length of 6 feet.
- Campers **MUST** only use firewood purchased in the local area. A quarantine for the emerald ash borer restricts the transport of firewood to or from the county.

### Interagency Passes Available to the Public

The National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Interagency Senior and Access passes provide camping discounts at the national lakeshore. ### Prohibited Activities

- Possession/consumption of alcoholic beverages
- Driving over 15 MPH on campground roads
- Bicycles/vehicles off paved roads
- Wood gathering/cutting
- Campfires outside of provided grates
- Driving nails in trees
- Bathing/washing at water outlets
- Disturbing/hunting/capturing wildlife or plants
- Fireworks
- Burning trash in campfires, especially plastics
