Centennial Passport Stamp

Record your centennial visit in your National Parks Passport Book with a special cancellation stamp available at the Kohm Yah-mah-nee Visitor Center and Loomis Museum.

Lassen Annual Pass

Give the gift that keeps on giving to yourself or a loved one. This year's Lassen Volcanic National Park Annual Pass (also honored at Whiskeytown National Recreation Area) features an historic image in celebration of the park's 100th anniversary.

Trail Challenge Bandana

Keepsakes and Commemorative Items


Enjoy a variety of commemorative items from the park's bookstores or gift shops including items featuring the Lassen and NPS centennial logos.


FIND YOUR PARK
