Participation Requirements:

- Register prior to paddle
- Physically able to complete a two hour paddle
- Have basic swimming skills
- Not afraid of falling into the water
- Weight limit is 250 lbs. per person.
- Each child must be over the age of 10 and must meet the above requirements, and be accompanied by an adult and be able to paddle without assistance
- Life jackets will be worn properly at all times during the paddle and only taken off when on land.
- Participants exhibiting intoxicated or inappropriate behavior will be asked to leave.
- Sign and bring the release of liability form (one for each person) the day of your reservation.
- The paddle could be canceled because of inclement or unsafe weather conditions.

Please arrive on time 15 minutes before the starting time. The first 30 minutes will be a safety and boat use orientation. **If the participant(s) miss this orientation their reservation will be cancelled.**

Participants should dress and bring the following the day of the paddle

- Clothing that can get wet
 - Layer and protective clothing such as windbreakers
 - Hat and Sunglasses Water (a bottle for each person), snacks, sunscreen and insect repellent
 - Footwear must be worn at all times. Examples are Texas river sandals or old tennis shoes. No flip-flops or high heels.
- Change of clothes and towel to be left in the participant's vehicle incase participant gets wet
- Release of liability form.
