


A Full Circle of History



The Woodstock Inn operated an electric bus in the early 1900s for tourists and residents. The bus connected the old train station to the Woodstock Inn and other village destinations.

A full century later, the train station is gone, but the Full Circle Trolley is traveling along many of the same roads providing public transportation to our community.

A Full Circle of Energy



The trolley is charged each night using 100% renewable energy purchased from the Central Vermont Public Service (CVPS) Cow Power program. The power is produced by methane from manure that runs generators. Farms from across Vermont participate in and benefit from the program.

A Full Circle of Conservation



The Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historical Park includes the mansion, grounds, and scenic carriage trails that wind through forests and fields. The Park's land tells the story of

conservation in America as influenced by a succession of forward-thinking individuals and families. The Full Circle Trolley embraces that conservation mission and extends the lessons of the land to the transportation system.

The Full Circle Route



The Trolley operates on a twenty minute village loop making connections to our businesses and community attractions. Maps and route schedules are

available at most businesses, The Woodstock Welcome Center, the Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historical Park and on the Trolley.






