The visitor center is located in a small office park. The one-story building is made of tan concrete block with a textured surface. The low peaked roof is red metal with vertical seams. The visitor center is near the middle of the building in a square section turned so that one corner reaches almost to the sidewalk along the parking lot. The front door is in the middle of the right side of that square. There is a flagpole on either side of the walk that leads to the front door. The wall to the left of the door and down the left side is solid windows with red trim to match the roof color.

As you enter the double doors, the L-shaped information desk is ahead and slightly to the left, past a square support pillar in the middle of the space. There is a sitting area to the left of the door with two armchairs, a sofa and a square coffee table in the middle.
