Rules and Guidelines

1. Please stay on the trail.

Our park is home to rattlesnakes! The best way to avoid a rattlesnake bite is to stay on the marked and paved trail. They will not bite unless they are disturbed or provoked.

2. Please leave artifacts, plants and animals in their place.

Feel free to take pictures of what you see, but please leave items where you found them so that everyone can enjoy them.

3. Please help to keep our wildlife wild.

Feeding wild animals may seem like a nice thing to do, but it actually can make the animals sick or dependant on humans. Also, some of our animals carry diseases. Touching, petting or feeding wild animals could put you at risk for catching these diseases.

4. Please leave the park neater than you found it.

Pick up any trash you find on the trail. If you choose to have lunch in our picnic area, please deposit trash in the trash bins by the visitor's center.

5. Please share the park with others.

During your visit, you will not be alone in the park. Other visitors from all over the world come to enjoy Montezuma Castle. Please share the space by using inside voices in the museum, staying with your group and walking (not running) on the trails.
