



*If you see what appears to be imprinting of either safety or nitrate along an edge, but it is not embossed, you may have a duplicate negative OR an actual nitrate or acetate film. Perform close examination of the film and perform the polarization test.

**For x-ray film - if the film is dated before 1930 assume it is cellulose nitrate.
For arial film - If the film is dated before 1940 assume it is cellulose nitrate.

***Although Kodak ceased manufacturing cellulose nitrate sheet film ca. 1950 the stock material may have been available and used into the mid-1950s. Also other manufacturers may have produced cellulose nitrate film well into the 1950s.
