- Locate Pennsylvania, South Carolina, and Mississippi on your map. Using a straight edge and pencil, draw a line dividing each of these states in half. Each half will be a different color.
- Locate Texas on your map and using a straight edge and pencil, draw lines dividing Texas into quarters or four sections. Texas will be finished with four different colors.
- Locate "DC" (Washington, D.C.) use a small red line to highlight the first aid relief provided for the Grand Army of the Republic Encampment. Glen Echo, Maryland is near Washington, D.C.
- Use the chart and color the proper state for each of the American Red Cross fields of service.

Droughts - black	Famines – green	Hurricanes - purple
Earthquakes - brown	Fires - orange	Wars - red
