ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FILE FOR  
OPERABLE UNIT 2 OF  
THE WASHINGTON GAS – EAST STATION SITE  
NATIONAL CAPITAL PARKS- EAST**

The National Park Service (NPS) announces the availability of the Administrative Record File for Operable Unit 2 (OU2) of the Washington Gas - East Station Site for public review. The site is located at 12<sup>th</sup> and Water Street, SE, Washington, D.C., and OU2 deals with groundwater, surface water, and sediments of the Anacostia River where hazardous substances released at or from the Washington Gas property have come to be located.

The OU2 Administrative Record includes the documents that NPS will use to select a CERCLA response action for OU2. Documents now in the Administrative Record File include, but are not limited to, previous investigation reports, the OU1 Record of Decision, the site-wide Community Involvement Plan, ongoing tar removal reports, the OU2 Work Plan, and the Project Operation Plan. The Administrative Record will be updated as the OU2 investigation progresses. Additional documents that will be added to the Administrative Record File include the OU2 Remedial Investigation Report, Feasibility Study, Proposed Plan, Record of Decision, comments submitted by interested persons, and NPS responses to significant comments.
