This tool assists managers in making informed, purposeful choices about how to respond to the trajectory of change and provides a straightforward approach to support resource managers in collaborating across jurisdictions.

Managed Relocation

Managed relocation—also known as assisted dispersal or assisted migration—intends to protect species by relocating them to locations with more favorable biotic or climatic conditions.
