

Sand Point Ice Climbing and Viewing

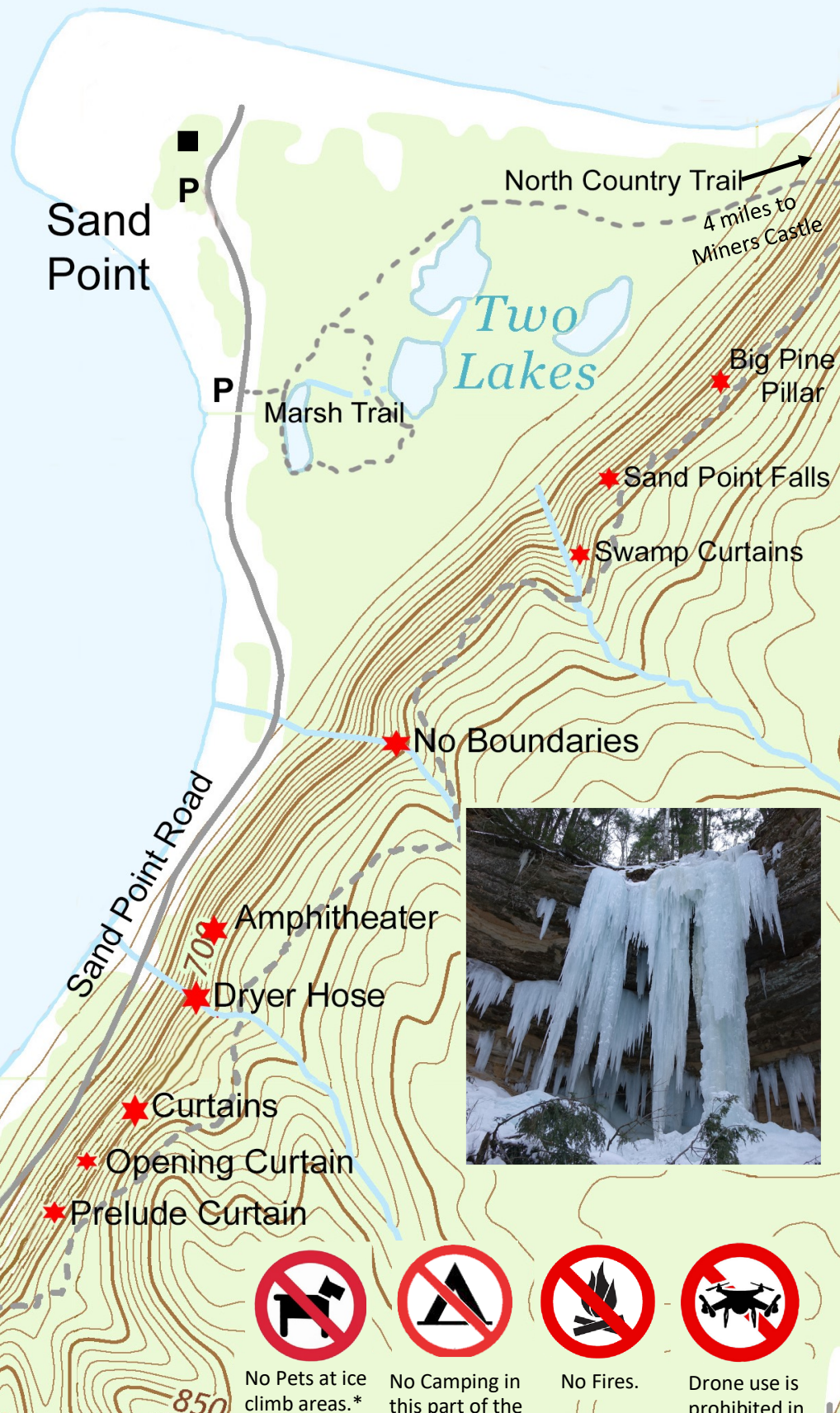


The easiest ice to access can be found along the Pictured Rocks escarpment between Munising Falls and Sand Point along Sand Point Road. You can find ice columns and blue ice curtains from 20 to 50 feet tall.

- Park at Munising Falls or Sand Point and walk along the road.
- Expect slippery travel. Spikes, ice cleats, or snowshoes are recommended.
- No ice climbing at Munising Falls or travel beyond the railings.
- Keep off the groomed cross-country ski trails.

Lake Superior Danger: Lake ice conditions vary. Beware of thin ice & hidden open water. Between Sand Point and Grand Island, there is a deep water channel with shifting currents.

The park does not check the condition of lake ice to deem it safe or unsafe. Our only recommendation is to **stay off the ice!**



No Pets at ice climb areas.*
