## Tomales Bay State Park, Millerton Point Closure During Restoration Project

*INVERNESS, Calif.* – Millerton Point at Tomales Bay State Park will be closing Nov. 1-18, 2015 for a restoration project to improve native habitat.

The restoration project includes: Removal of invasive plants and revegetation with native plants collected on-site. All other areas of Tomales Bay SP will remain open during the project.
