




Letterboxing at Prince William Forest Park *Laurel Loop Trail*



Follow the clues to find your letterbox!

1. At the Visitor Center you will start on this quest to do your part. Stand in front of the petrified wood, toward the Visitor Center look you should.
2. Go to the fire hydrant to your left and you will see a wide brown path right through the trees. It will take you to the dark enclosed building where you need to be.
3. Walk past this building, then to the fountain, now just 12 more paces as part of your trek, and you will spy the black railing that will lead you to the steps.
4. These steps will take you to the black top. Where once you arrive you will need to stop. On your right go to the field behind the railed fence. This clue applies to all ladies and gents.
5. Look to the far side of this field and you will spy a forked tree. Walk to this tree, then stop, and you will see on closer inspection it's shaped like a "V".
6. Continue past one bright yellow blaze on a tree the trail is as pretty as can be. Stroll on down the hill into the woods. On your left another forked tree see you should.
7. Halt 6 feet before the third blaze and see on your left a rather large holly tree. Beyond that holly is a big oak tree, standing with all its majesty.



8. It appears burned on one side but oh what a great place to hide! Come and find me behind the tree, Where hopefully I will still be.
