Lower St. Croix River Camping Permit Application

Visitors who plan to camp outside of the state parks in the stretch of river between US Highway 8 (river mile 52.5) and the Soo Line High Bridge (river mile 29.5) are required to have a camping permit. Read each item below and check the adjacent box to acknowledge your understanding of these regulations.

 □ Visitors must camp in designated campsites. □ Individual sites accomodate up to 8 people and 3 tents. Group sites accomodate 9 to 16 people and up to 6 tents. Larger groups need to split up or camp in one of the state park campgrounds. □ There is a 3-night limit of stay. There is a 30-night limit for the season. □ All campsites must be occupied on the first night of stay. Any equipment will be removed from a site that is unoccupied for 24 hours. □ Attach the camping permit you receive to the tent so it is clearly visible. The camping permit must be displayed every time you camp during the year it is issued. □ Alcohol is prohibited at Eagle's Nest campsites (river mile 48.5). □ Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am.
