Passamaquoddy Basket Weaving Demonstrations

Visit with National Park Ranger George Neptune as he demonstrates the traditional basket weaving techniques of his tribe, the Passamaquoddy. Try your hand at weaving a few rows! *10-15 minutes.*

Meeting of Two Worlds

Participate in a hands-on program designed to introduce the history of the 1604 French settlement on Saint Croix Island. *45 minutes.*
