HARBOR CRUISE INFORMATION

All Salem Maritime Festival Visitors are Invited to Enter a Drawing for ONE FREE BOAT RIDE on the Vessel of their Choice

HOW IT WORKS: Random drawings will be held 30 minutes prior to each departure. Ticketed passengers (only) should be prepared for immediate departure down the Central Wharf gangway, and will come aboard, meet the crew and join in the hands-on activities. All children under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult.

SCHEDULED DEPARTURES for the 90-minute boat rides are:

- 10:30am** *Schooner Fame* (Ticket drawing 10:00 am)
- 10:45am** *Vessel Finback* (Ticket drawing 10:15 am)
- 12:15am** *Schooner Fame* (Ticket drawing 11:45 am)
- 12:30pm** *Vessel Finback* (Ticket drawing 12:00 am)
- 2:00pm** *Schooner Fame* (Ticket drawing 1:30 pm)
- 2:15pm** *Vessel Finback* (Ticket drawing 1:45 pm)

TICKET INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Each Festival Visitor receives one chance (ticket).
2. Complete your chance with your name and the number in your party (maximum number in party allowed is 4 persons). Each person in your party may fill out one chance.
3. Place your chance in the drawing bucket (designated by vessel/time) of your choice.
4. Visitors must be present at the time of drawing.
5. Each person is only allowed ONE boat ride trip.
6. Visitors may get back in line for one additional chance if they miss out the first time.

Ticketed passengers (only) must be prepared for immediate departure at Central Wharf gangway

Trip length: 90-minutes rides around Salem Harbor

Age Limitation: All children under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult

Safety: All vessels are USCG approved and carry all necessary safety equipment

- Visit *Friendship of Salem* - Open all day, free-of-charge and will host the Jr. Ranger Program
- Visit *Friendship of Salem's* Jolly Boat for short rowing trips on a first-come, first-serve basis*

- Visit the USCG Motor Life Boat (Central Wharf) for an onboard tour and rescue stories
