Francisco Sisneros is a retired educator and avid genealogical researcher. His area of expertise is in the Rio Abajo region, spanning from the 1600s to the early 1900s. He is a dedicated volunteer and co-founder of the *Hispanic Genealogical Research Center of New Mexico*.

Francisco Sisneros was born in Abo, New Mexico, next to the old mission ruins of San Gregorio, his family has roots there going back to the mid-1600s. Francisco has written over forty articles based on primary records on New Mexico history and on the origins of the Hispanic families of New Mexico.
