




2016 Saratoga National Historical Park Student Artwork Contest

Saratoga National Historical Park is accepting submissions from fourth through seventh grade students for the park's Annual Pass Artwork Contest. The purpose of the student contest is to promote stewardship and understanding of resources protected within Saratoga National Historical Park. The focus for this contest is for young artists to create and submit original, colorful artwork that illustrates the beauty of Saratoga National Historical Park in celebration of the National Park Service Centennial in 2016. The first place winning entry will be the artwork on Saratoga's 2016 Annual Park Pass - over 1,000 passes are sold each year!



Entry Guidelines

Each entry for the contest must include original, colorful artwork depicting one or more of the natural or cultural resources protected in the park. A banner will be inserted on the artwork of the first place winning artwork for use on the 2016 park pass, as shown above. A signed and completed entry form (below) must accompany all submissions and be e-mailed by a parent or guardian to megan_stevens@nps.gov by Friday, November 27, 2015.

Judging and Prizes

Entries will be judged on design and creativity of a scene that illustrates the beauty of Saratoga National Historical Park. Art may include any natural or cultural resource of the park, or symbol of the National Park Service. Entries must be in color and will be judged on originality, neatness, and the use of color. The top ten entries will be displayed on Facebook (@SaratogaNHP) where the public will cast their vote. Winners will be announced Friday, December 4, 2015 and will be notified by e-mail.
